

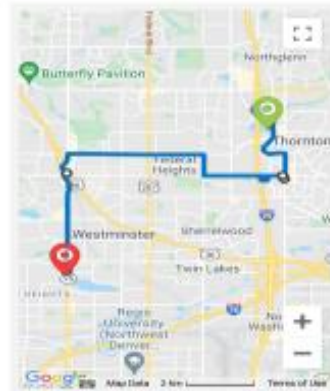

WHERE AND HOW TO BUY TICKETS:

PREPAID TICKETS:

Participating King Soopers and Safeway stores. Online using the www.RTD-Denver.com or RTD App (Apple/Google Play app store), at main transit centers/sales outlets throughout the metro area <https://www.rtd-denver.com/fares-passes/passes-ticket-books/sales-outlets>

TYPES OF TICKETS:

SINGLE USE: These may be purchased at bus stops, transit centers or prepay.

3-HOUR CASH PASS: Exact change, credit/debit not accepted. Fare includes a 3-Hour Pass good for unlimited trips. These are also available on the RTD app. Single use tickets are not sold at King Soopers or Safeway. Only books, passes or MYRIDE cards. Cash (exact change) may be used as drivers don't carry change.

DAY PASS: Unlimited rides on bus/rail all day for price of a round-trip. May be purchased onboard (cash-only), at RTD ticket vending machines and using the RTD Mobile Tickets App. Also sold at King Soopers and Safeway. Pricing: <https://www.rtd-denver.com/fares-passes/day-pass>

10-RIDE TICKET BOOKS: A book of 10 individual paper tickets valid for 3-hour travel each. Pricing: <https://www.rtd-denver.com/fares-passes/passes-ticket-books/ticket-books>

MONTHLY PASS: Unlimited rides on bus and train using a paper pass. Pricing: <https://www.rtd-denver.com/fares-passes/monthly-pass>

MYRIDE: Our most convenient and popular reloadable fare card (load up to \$200 cash). Simply tap your card on the smart card reader to pay your fare. No need for exact change for transfers. Reload your card online, at RTD Transit Centers, King Soopers and Safeway stores. www.rtd-denver.com/myride

Ready to get off the bus? Pull the string above the windows and exit when the driver stops. The driver will be able to provide you with a transfer if you need one and provide additional information as needed.

DISCOUNTS:

Active-duty members of the U.S. military ride for free on all RTD services.

Discount fares are available for all seniors 65+, individuals with disabilities, Medicare recipients, and youth (ages 6-19). Children five years of age or younger ride free with a fare-paying adult (limit three children with each fare-paying adult).

LIVE PROGRAM: An income-based fare discount (up to 40% off) is available for qualifying riders who enroll. Ages 20-64, meet requirements and live in the RTD service area is required for all passengers using discounted fare products.

DISCOUNT FARES

RTD offers discount fares for seniors, individuals with disabilities, Medicare recipients, and youth. We also offer an income-based discount through our LIVE program, for those who qualify.

IF YOU RIDE THE BUS OR TRAIN WITH A DISCOUNT PASS OR TICKET, YOU MUST SHOW ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AS PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY:

YOUTH
Youth ages 6-19 receive a 70 percent discount by showing:

- Middle or high school ID, or
- Government-issued photo ID showing passenger's age, or
- RTD-issued Youth Special Discount Card

Up to three children ages 5 and younger ride free with a fare-paying adult.

INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES
Passengers receive a 50 percent discount by showing:

- Medicare card, or
- RTD-issued Special Discount Card

LIVE
Individuals enrolled in LIVE, RTD's income-based fare discount program, receive a 40 percent discount and must show a LIVE Discount Identification card when using one of these forms of fare media:

- LIVE Mobile card, or
- LIVE Mobile ticket, 24-hour pass, or 30-day pass, or
- LIVE ticket issued to a government or nonprofit agency

To qualify for LIVE, you must be between the ages of 20 and 64, live within the RTD service area, and have a household income at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level.

Children five years of age or younger ride free with a fare-paying adult (limit three children with each fare-paying adult).

- Alien registration/permanent resident card
- Military identification/dependent card with date of birth
- Middle or high school student identification card

Senior (65+)

- Birth certificate or passport
- Valid state-issued identification card or driver's license
- Alien registration/permanent resident card
- Military identification/dependent card with date of birth
- Medical benefit card with date of birth

DISABLED SPECIAL DISCOUNT APPLICATIONS:

INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES:

- **MEDICARE VALIDATION:** Applicant must submit a copy of their Medicare card. *Medicaid* card will not be accepted
- **SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE OR SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME:** Applicant must provide printout of their Social Security Benefits statement with the words "disabled individual" dated within the last year.
- **DISABLED VETERANS VALIDATION:** Applicant has a service-connected disability and must submit a copy of a benefit letter from the Veterans Administration (VA). The letter must state disability is over 50% service connected and dated within the last year.
- **HEALTH CARE PROVIDER'S STATEMENT:** Application must be completed by an M.D., D.O., N.P., or P.A. ONLY. Must be signed and dated within the last three months (90 days). Health Care Provider's Statement is found in the [Individuals with Disabilities Special Discount Card application](#).
